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Statement by Terry Davis, Secretary General of the Council of Europe on the suicide bomber attack in Ingushetia

Strasbourg, 17.05.2006 - "I feel anger and profound sadness at the news of a new terrorist attack in the Russian Federation. Seven people were killed this morning in a suicide bomber attack in Ingushetia adding to an already long list of victims of terrorism in Russia. On behalf of the Council of Europe and personally, I wish to express condolences to the families of the people who were killed.

Terrorists aim at sowing fear and instability, but instead, in reaction to their crimes, the solidarity between peoples and countries, and our common resolve to defeat terrorism, are only growing stronger.

Terrorists are nothing but common criminals, they have no cause, and they have no future."

Strasbourg, 17.05.2006 – « Je ressens de la colère et une profonde tristesse à la nouvelle de l'attentat terroriste qui vient de survenir en Fédération de Russie. Au nom du Conseil de l'Europe et personnellement, je tiens à exprimer mes condoléances aux familles des personnes qui ont été tuées.

Les terroristes cherchent à répandre la peur et l'instabilité, mais au lieu de cela, face à de tels crimes, la solidarité entre les peuples et les pays, ainsi que notre résolution commune à vaincre le terrorisme, n'en sont que renforcées.

Les terroristes ne sont que de vulgaires criminels, sans cause et sans avenir ».

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
