Council of Europe Secretary General on the results of the referendum in Montenegro

Strasbourg, 23.05.2006 - "The conduct of the referendum was a significant test of the democratic maturity of Montenegrins. The second and even more important challenge begins today. Democracy is first and foremost about how people manage their disagreements. Everyone in Montenegro shares the responsibility for reconciling divisions within their society, and the government must live up to its promises of independence as an opportunity to improve the lives of all Montenegrin citizens through a better economy, less corruption, more democracy, a higher standard of human rights, and close relations with neighbouring countries" said Terry Davis today.
