## **PACE President: Election of Serbian Speaker – an important signal for the international community**

Strasbourg, 23.05.2007 - Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly (PACE) President René van der Linden today warmly welcomed the election of Oliver Dulić (DS) as the new Speaker of the Serbian Parliament. "His election is an important signal for the international community. He is a committed democrat and a convinced European which he has shown as former chairman of the European Integration Committee of the now-defunct parliament of the State Union of Serbia and Montenegro. This is good news for the country and its people, for its further European integration and last but not least for the Council of Europe, as Serbia has just taken over the Chairmanship of the Organisation's executive, the Committee of Ministers, for six months," Mr van der Linden said.

"As I am currently on an official visit to Serbia, I am now looking forward to meet with Mr Dulić in order to discuss the country's chairmanship in the 47-member Organisation, further integration of Serbia, co-operation with the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY), the issue of Kosovo and ways in which our Parliamentary Assembly can assist the Parliament in implementing further democratic and legal reform," the PACE President concluded.
