Council of Europe Secretary General calls on Libya to deport the five Bulgarian nurses and the doctor to Bulgaria

Strasbourg, 18.07.2007 - "I am relieved that Libya's High Judicial Council has commuted the death penalty verdict of the Bulgarian medical staff and that they are no longer under threat of execution. The priority now should be to secure their deportation to Bulgaria. At the same time, my thoughts are with the infected children, and I hope that the latest developments in this tragic situation will also bring some relief to their suffering" said Terry Davis.
