Tents against anti-Semitism bring "All Different – All Equal" youth to Europe's capitals

Strasbourg, 10.09.2007 – Paris, Kiev and Warsaw are the venue for a day-long "<u>All Different – All Equal</u>" campaign event dedicated to Jewish culture, interreligious dialogue, and the fight against anti-Semitism on the 18th of September.

Tents are to be placed in the main squares of each city to show visitors Jewish culture, heritage, history and the importance of eradicating anti-Semitism. The event aims to encourage inter-cultural and inter-religious dialogue with open air classrooms, panel discussions, exhibitions, conferences, tours, sessions, meetings, and concerts.

To organise the event, the cities' Jewish communities and organisations will join forces with the Council of Europe's Directorate of Youth and Sport. The contributors include the European Jewish Congress (EJC), the World Jewish Congress' (WJC) Future Generations division, the B'nai B'rith International's European Union Affairs Office, the European Union of Jewish Students (EUJS) and the Conference of European Rabbis (CER).

"All Different – All Equal" is a youth campaign against discrimination and racism and in support of human rights, diversity, and participation.
