PACE to observe the 2nd round of the presidential election in Serbia

Strasbourg, 01.02.2008 – A delegation of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE), led by Andreas Gross (Switzerland, SOC) will visit Serbia from 1 to 4 February to observe the second round of the presidential election, alongside the OSCE and the ODIHR.

The two parliamentarians should have meetings with a representative of the Election Commission and members of the Association of Independent Journalists of Serbia, before observing the holding of the election and vote counting on 3 February.
