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Secretary General Terry Davis on the murder of former Socialist town councillor in Spain

Strasbourg, 07.03.2008 – I condemn in the strongest terms the ruthless murder of former town councillor Isaías Carrasco in Spain today.

Mr Carrasco was reportedly killed in the presence of his wife and daughter. The people who carried out this murder are nothing but common criminals. The assassination takes place two days before the general elections in Spain, but I am convinced that the voters will not let themselves be intimidated and influenced by what appears to be a terrorist attack.

I wish to express my sincere condolences to the family of Mr Carrasco and to the Spanish people.

Strasbourg, 07.03.2008 – Je n'ai pas de mots assez forts pour condamner le lâche assassinat d'un ancien conseiller municipal, Isaías Carrasco, survenu aujourd'hui en Espagne.

M. Carrasco aurait été abattu en présence de sa femme et de sa fille. Les auteurs de ce meurtre ne sont que de vulgaires criminels. Cet assassinat se produit deux jours avant les législations législatives en Espagne, mais je suis convaincu que les électeurs ne se laisseront pas intimider et influencer par ce qui semble être un attentat terroriste.

Je présente mes sincères condoléances à la famille de M. Carrasco et au peuple espagnol.

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
