PACE elects four judges to the European Court of Human Rights

Strasbourg, 15.04.2008 – The Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE), meeting this week in plenary session in Strasbourg, today elected four judges to the European Court of Human Rights. They are the following:

- Khanlar Hajiiev, in respect of Azerbaijan;
- Nebojša Vučinić, in respect of Montenegro;
- Antonella Mularoni, in respect of San Marino;
- Boštjan Zupančič, in respect of Slovenia.

Judges are elected by the Parliamentary Assembly from lists of three candidates nominated by each State which has ratified the European Convention on Human Rights.
