## Seminar on transfrontier co-operation and the "Dnipro" Euroregion

Strasbourg, 26.06.2008 – Developments in the field of transfrontier cooperation in Europe and the activities of the Dnipro Euroregion (Ukraine-Russian Federation-Belarus) will be the highlights of a seminar which is being held on 30 June in Cherniquiv, Ukraine.
