Statement by Terry Davis, Secretary General and Maud de Boer-Buquicchio, Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe

Strasbourg, 03.07.2008 – We are delighted and relieved by the news that Ingrid Betancourt and fourteen other hostages held by the FARC in Colombia have been freed.

This is a moment of joy for them, for their families and for all the people across the world who never gave up the campaign for their freedom. Our thoughts are now with the hundreds of people who are still being held by the Colombian rebels, and we hope that their day of freedom will come very soon.
