Turkey Ukraine United Kinadom Strasbourg, 26.09.2008 - A delegation of the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe will pay a visit to Bosnia and Herzegovina, from 3 to 6 October, to observe municipal elections on Sunday 5 October. The delegation will be headed by Marie-Rose Koro (France, SOC) and will also include four members of the Committee of the Regions of the European Union. As part of cooperation between the two institutions, the Committee of the Regions regularly participates in Congress' election observation

Prior to election day, the delegation will meet with representatives of the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina, candidates standing for election and representatives of political parties, as well as members of the national delegation to the Congress and representatives of the international community.

On 5 October, the delegation will be deployed in different polling stations in Sarajevo, Banja Luka, Mostar, Srebrenica and Brcko to observe the voting and ballot counting.

A press conference will be held in the Neretva Meeting Room of Holiday Inn Hotel in Sarajevo on Monday 6 October at 5 pm.
