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Council of Europe Secretary General reacts to the death of Ibrahim Rugova

Strasbourg, 21.01.2006 - "On behalf of the Council of Europe I should like to express my sincere condolences to the people of Kosovo, who have lost a historic leader," said Terry Davis, Secretary General of the Council of Europe.

"Ibrahim Rugova was a politician who believed in peace, and was ready to take risks for it. He died on the eve of the opening of the talks on the future of Kosovo which should lead to a just, peaceful and democratic solution for Kosovo and bring stability and prosperity to all its citizens. I could not think of a more appropriate way to pay tribute to President Rugova," concluded the Secretary General.
