 mandated substitutes) from at least two delegations for the texts debated in plenary sittings, or 5 members for those
 of the Chambers. Each amendment must specify the name of the member who will submit it.
- Registration of speakers for the debates: the form for registration of speakers for the debates must be submitted
 to the Table Office secretariat seated beside the President's rostrum.
- Finance Office for reimbursement of travel and subsistence expenses: Office 1040.
