Prosecutors' Network in South Eastern Europe to hold conference on its future

Date: Monday 26 April 2010 at 10.00 am

Place: Tirana (Albania) – Rogner Hotel Europapark (Vienna-Prague conference room), Bulevardi Dëshmoret e Kombit

Description: Representatives of the 7 project areas and other regional and European networking initiatives in the field of the fight against transborder crime will meet to define new ways to develop the Network and strengthen its co-operation with EUROJUST, the European Judicial Network and Southeast European Prosecutors Advisory Group, and to reinforce the role of the Network in the International Law Enforcement Cooperation Units (ILECUs).

The conference will try to identify the potential of the Prosecutors' Network, propose sustainable solutions and discuss new tasks for the Network. The conference participants will likely adopt conclusions indicating directions for the development of the Network as well as the areas where further international technical assistance is required.
