

**Organised by:** the Council of Europe in the framework of the Joint Project with the European Union on strengthening and protecting women's and children's rights in Ukraine (TRES Project).

**Description:** Ukrainian politicians, administrators, law enforcement officials and NGOs will meet international experts, among them representatives of the Ombudspersons for Children Offices, to discuss measures to promote gender equality and children's rights in line with the European Social Charter (revised) and other international standards.

This international conference will conduct a comparative analysis of the guarantees of children's rights and gender equality in different European States to help Ukraine build a modern national policy aiming at overcoming the deficiency of gender sensitivity and at observing women's and children's rights and to encourage better implementation of the Charter.
