Description

Over 600 political leaders, civil society activists, journalists and business leaders from 16 European countries will meet in Strasbourg to discuss the impact of contemporary challenges to democratic values, human rights and the rule of law, as promoted by the Council of Europe since its creation in 1949.

The Summer University is the annual highlight of the Council of Europe's 16 schools of political studies which aim to train the next generation of political, economic, social and cultural leaders in transition countries.

 Political Studies Catherine Lalumiere and Michel Rocard, former French prime
 Minister, are among the opening speakers.
- Lilian Thuram, President of the Lilian Thuram Foundation-Education against Racism, will participate in the closing session on Friday 10 July at which a final declaration is due to be adopted.
