#### Parliamentary Assembly's spring session: Belarus, Turkey, Albania and Monaco

Strasbourg, 19.04.2004 - Disappeared persons and the persecution of the press in Belarus, the honouring of commitments by Turkey and Albania, and Monaco's application for membership of the Council of Europe top the agenda of the Assembly's spring session (Strasbourg, 26-30 April 2004).

Reports on the strengthening of the United Nations, on euthanasia and on the situation of European prisons and pre-trial detention centres will also be debated. There have been requests for urgent debates on the situation in Kosovo and the new Dutch policy on asylum-seekers.

Croatian Prime Minister Ivo Sanader (Tuesday 27), Netherlands Prime Minister Peter Balkenende and Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Netherlands and Chairman of the Committee of Ministers Bernard Bot (Wednesday 28), and Azerbaijan President Ilham Aliyev (Thursday 29) are among guest speakers.

Monaco National Council President Stéphane Valéri, Kazakhstan Senate Speaker Nurtay Abikayev (Tuesday 27), and the UN Secretary General's Special Representative in Kosovo Harri Holkeri (Thursday 29) will also address the Assembly.

Peter Schieder, President of the Parliamentary Assembly, will give a press conference on Monday 26 April at 11 a.m. (Room 1). Other press conferences will be announced on the spot.
