Description: The seminar will take place within the framework of "PROSECO: Support to Prosecutors' Network in South Eastern Europe", the joint regional project of the Council of Europe and the European Commission. It will concentrate on the legal preconditions and restrictions of special investigative means as well as their application. The target groups are prosecutors, judiciary officials and law enforcement officers. The participants will be acquainted with investigative and surveillance tools and their implementation.
