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Graduation ceremony of the National Institute of Justice of Moldova

Strasbourg, 04.03.2009 - The Secretary General has been invited to visit Chişinău (Moldova) on 5 and 6 March in order to attend the first graduation ceremony of the National Institute of Justice.

Two years ago the Secretary General took part in the inauguration of the National Institute of Justice which Moldova had established as part of its judicial reform effort with the help of the Council of Europe. The Institute provides initial and in-service training for judges and prosecutors in order to raise the level of professionalism and efficiency of the judicial system.

On Thursday 5 March, Terry Davis will meet the first group of graduates who have benefited from a curriculum developed in co-operation with the Council of Europe.
