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Tomorrow's demonstration in Tbilisi

Statement by Spain's Minister for Foreign Affairs and Co-operation, Miguel Ángel Moratinos, Chairman of the Committee of Ministers

Strasbourg, 08.04.2009 - "On the eve of the opposition demonstration which is to take place in Tbilisi tomorrow, I call on the Georgian authorities, the organisers and the participants in the demonstration to act in a responsible and peaceful manner and exercise maximum restraint.

Dialogue between political forces is the only course of action which can bear fruitful results for the future of Georgia. It is the responsibility of all Georgian political leaders to secure such a dialogue and the support of the population to this process."
