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Moldova: PACE to observe the anticipated parliamentary elections

Strasbourg, 24.07.2009 – A Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly (PACE) delegation led by Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu (Turkey, EDG) will be visiting Moldova from 27 to 30 July 2009 to observe the anticipated parliamentary elections on Wednesday 29, alongside observers from the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly, the European Parliament and the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (OSCE/ODIHR).

The delegation is to meet notably the President of the Central Electoral Commission and representatives of the political parties standing in the election, civil society and the media, before observing the ballot in a sample of polling stations across the country.

Preliminary conclusions will be announced during a press conference on Thursday 30 July (place and time to be confirmed).

Moldova : l'APCE observera les élections législatives anticipées

Strasbourg, 24.07.2009 - Une délégation de l'Assemblée parlementaire du Conseil de l'Europe (APCE), conduite par Mevlüt Çavuşoğlu (Turquie, GDE), se rendra en Moldova du 27 au 30 juillet 2009 pour observer les élections législatives anticipées du mercredi 29, aux côtés d'observateurs de l'Assemblée parlementaire de l'OSCE, du Parlement européen et du Bureau des institutions démocratiques et des droits de l'homme (OSCE/BIDDH).

La délégation doit rencontrer notamment le Président de la Commission centrale électorale, ainsi que des représentants des partis politiques en lice, de la société civile et des médias, avant d'observer le scrutin dans un échantillon de bureaux de vote à travers le pays.

Les conclusions préliminaires seront annoncées lors d'une conférence de presse le jeudi 30 juillet (lieu et horaire à confirmer).

The Parliamentary Assembly brings together 318 members from the national parliaments of the 47 member states.
