Commissioner Hammarberg to speak at the celebrations for the 70th anniversary of CIMADE

Strasbourg, $24.09.2009 - On 26^{th}$ of September, Thomas Hammarberg, Council of Europe's Commissioner for Human Rights, will take part in the launching of the celebrations for the 70^{th} anniversary of CIMADE – one of the French leading NGOs on migrants and refugees' rights.

The <u>event</u> is organised by CIMADE at the "Palais Universitaire" in Strasbourg. It will consist of three round tables which discuss migration movements across Europe and debate on present European migration policies. In particular, the closing round table will focus on ways and modalities to build a European space which respects the values of justice, peace and cohesion and strengthens the protection of migrants' rights.
