PACE elects Guido Raimondi judge of the European Court of Human Rights with respect to Italy

Strasbourg, 26.01.2010 - The Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE), meeting this week in plenary session in Strasbourg, today elected Guido Raimondi as judge to the European Court of Human Rights with respect to Italy.

Judges are elected by PACE from a list of three candidates nominated by each State which has ratified the European Convention on Human Rights.
