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The Council of Europe deplores the terrorist attacks in Russia

Declaration by the Chairperson of the Committee of Ministers, Micheline Calmy-Rey

Strasbourg, 29.03.2010 - "I am deeply saddened by the deadly explosions which took place this morning in two metro stations in Moscow. I wish to express my sincere condolences to the families and friends of the victims and solidarity with the population and authorities of the Russian Federation.

There is no justification for such horrendous acts, which I condemn most firmly. These terrible attacks remind us of the absolute necessity to continue our efforts to combat terrorism through means which are respectful of human rights and democratic values."
