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The Council of Europe condemns the bombings in Dagestan (Russian Federation)

Joint statement by the Chair of the Committee of Ministers, Micheline Calmy-Rey, the President of the Parliamentary Assembly, Mevlüt Çavusoglu and the Secretary General of the Council of Europe, Thorbjørn Jagland.

Strasbourg, 31.03.2010 - "The Council of Europe strongly condemns the explosions in Dagestan (Russian Federation), which come only two days after the terrorist attacks in Moscow. We reiterate our message of support for and solidarity with the Russian Federation at this very difficult moment. We also wish to convey our condolences to the families of those killed and our solidarity with the persons injured in today's attacks."
