<u>Subject</u>: Response to the 26.9.2016 of the Bern Convention Secretariat Mail in relation to the Recommendation No 174 (2014) –Complaint No 2010/5 in Kyparissia Bay (Natura GR 2550005 site).

In response to your Mail of 26.9.2016 we would like to inform you that the Presidential Decree for the protection of, both the marine and terristrial areas of Kyparissia Bay, has been sent for legal

review to the relevant department of the Ministry of Environment and Energy. After the legal-technical treatment, the Presidential Decree will be sent initially for approvement to the Alternate Minister and Minister of Environment and Energy and then to the Council of State in order to process it.

We would further point out, that the provisions of the Ministerial Decision No 25794, published in the Government Gazzette ($141\Delta/24.5.2016$), suggest, until the adoption of the management plan, specific measures and restrictions regarding the activities on nesting areas, of the species *Caretta caretta*.

In response to your letter of 15-12-2015, we would like to inform you that in the context of the obligations that stem from the 92/43 Directive, the Ministry has recently issued a Ministerial Decision (No 25794) published in the Government Gazzette ($141\Delta/24.5.2016$) for the protection of both the Marine and Terristrial Areas in Kyparissia Bay according to the Law 3937/2011 (article 6 par 9). The Decision aims at providing a 3-year protective status until the legal procedures for the Presidential Decree issuing are completed.
